Population shift to alter county-supervisor district lines

At least 170,000 West Valley residents will vote next year in a different Maricopa County supervisor's district because of changes in the county's population.

District 4, the West Valley county supervisor's district, has had the greatest population growth since 2000, according to

2010 census data. As a result, Maricopa County elections officials will redraw district lines to balance voter representation in the five county-supervisor districts.

To calculate the target population for each district, elections officials divided the new county-wide population count by five. The formula sets a target of 763,423 residents in each district. Each district's total will be compared

with the target figure to determine which districts have too many or too few constituents and need new boundaries drawn.

"It was a big surprise to me that it (population growth) was all in the northwest area," said county Elections Director Karen Osborne.

There is no obvious way to redraw district lines, because the population density in some areas is higher than in others.

Elections officials therefore must redraw boundaries without significantly tipping the population balance in any of the districts.

All five supervisors are up for re-election in 2012.

Supervisor Andy Kunasek's District 3 stands to gain the most residents — 117,636 — to meet the target.

The county Elections Department is soliciting public input on

new district lines. The last two public meetings will be held today and May 3. Residents can propose their own district lines using an online tool, then submit it to the Elections Department by June 1.

Voters also can suggest which communities of interest they would like kept together, such as specific neighborhoods, retirement communities or Native

American communities.

"If they are good Republican voters, no matter where they put them, I will still be very happy with the way they're voting," said District 4 Supervisor Max Wilson, a West Valley Republican. Wilson said he plans to run for re-election in 2012.


The county also is consolidating polling places, which elections officials say could save the county about \$1 million per election cycle. There will be about 400 fewer polling places in the 2012 election.

In the 2010 election, about 90 percent of Maricopa County voters were registered on the permanent early voting list, Osborne said. Voters registered on the list can mail their ballots in rather than taking them to their respective polling places on Election Day.





Decennial redistricting adds work and costs for elections administrators

Political fights over redistricting cause delays and increase costs

Across the country, states are embroiled in the decennial process of redistricting that follows the release of the [latest data](#) from the U.S. Census Bureau. The process is often [fraught with controversy](#) and can drag on for months.

The impacts redistricting has on local elections officials varies from state to state. Redistricting is usually, but not exclusively, more taxing for an urban jurisdiction than a rural jurisdiction. Quite often an entire rural county is included in a legislative district or a Congressional district so the amount of additional work can be minimal.

"There is a huge burden placed on the office during redistricting because it all has to be accomplished in such a short time frame," said Edgardo Cortés, General Registrar, [Fairfax County Office of Elections](#).

According to Cortés, staff time is required to provide technical support and feedback during the process, including things like working with the GIS Department to produce maps of new district and precinct boundaries. The office is responsible for implementing all the changes in preparation for the next election. This includes working with the County Attorney's Office to write the legal descriptions for precincts; working with Public Affairs in outreach to voters to inform them of changes; and recruiting election officers and acquiring voting equipment for new precincts.

The costs associated with redistrict vary, with the bulk of the additional money going to staff overtime. In [Maricopa County, Ariz.](#), Recorder Helen Purcell says that it costs her office an additional \$10,000 to handle all the necessary costs associated with redistricting.

"Apart from the time costs associated with a few permanent staff who are involved in the redistricting process, there is the direct cost of the five temporary GIS technical staff (budgeted at \$138,000 per year for two years), and some computer hardware costs," explained Dean Logan, [Los Angeles County](#) registrar-recorder/county clerk. "In order to carry out the boundary line implementation, the GIS Section needed to update its computer hardware in order to utilize newer releases of the GIS software required for the effort, at a cost of \$14,000."

In Fairfax County, Cortés said each new precinct will cost approximately \$8,000 to \$10,000 to establish and a countywide mailing of new voter registration cards will cost \$350,000.

Like costs, the amount of participation local elections officials have in the redistricting process varies, although the amount of participation is usually limited to the redrawing of precinct lines within the newly

"My office is totally involved," Purcell said. "We provide the maps electronically and on paper for the general public. We hold the public hearings, take suggestions for change, develop all suggestions into maps for consideration by the Board of Supervisors. Finally, we make the submission to the Department of Justice for pre-clearance. This includes Board of Supervisors, Community College Board, Special Health Care Board, Justice of the Peace, Constables and Voting Precincts."






