

- Deadline to Register
 - August 1, 2016
- Statistics (as of 7/7/2016):
 - Total active registrants 2,031,043
 - Of those:
 - 1,340,986 are on the Permanent Early Voting List
 - 2,571 are military or overseas citizens

Early Voting

- Begins August 3, 2016
- Last day to request an early ballot be mailed August 19, 2016
- Mail early ballot back one week before election
 - August 23, 2016
 - *US Postal Service recommends 1 week also*
- Drop early ballot off at any polling location on Election Day
- Military and Overseas
 - Begins July 16, 2016
 - Last day to register August 30, 2016
 - Last day to submit early ballot August 30, 2016
- Special Election Board
 - Begins August 3, 2016
 - Last day to request August 19, 2016

POLLING PLACES

- 724 Polling Places
 - Approximately 700 of these were precleared by the Department of Justice in 2011
 - All have gone through ADA compliance checks
 - Goes before the Board 7/20/2016
 - Voters **MUST** go to their assigned Polling Place

Polling Places (continued)

- NO vote centers – WHY?
 - There are over 6,200 ballot styles
 - Equipment not capable of handling that many styles
- Ballot styles are determined by different things:
 - Political Party
 - Districts
 - Congressional
 - Legislative
 - County Board & Justice of the Peace
 - Precincts
 - City/Town
 - School
 - Special (fire, water, sanitary, hospital, etc.)


