- Arizona State Statute requires all counties to create a daily report of early ballot requests and returns from voters.
- These reports can be requested by bound districts (*Legislative, Congressional, Supervisorial, Precinct, or Countywide*) and provided daily or weekly throughout an election or as archived data.
- These daily reports must begin 33 days prior to the election, and for returns, end the day before Election Day.
- They are not intended to be a reconciliation of all early ballot requests and returns, as they are required to end prior to Election Day.
- This file also includes no protected voters (**A.R.S. § 16-153**).

Below is how Maricopa County and the political parties agreed to the file creation and sharing:

- EV32 Requested ballots: This is a daily data file created for political parties of early ballot requests from voters specific to an election.
- EV33 Returned ballots: This is a daily data file created for political parties of early ballots returned by voters. This is not a list of ballots that were counted. All early ballot envelopes must go through the exhaustive and comprehensive signature review process to verify the signature before it can be counted.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY OF THESE PROVISIONS, AS OUTLINED IN A.R.S. §16- 168(E) AND (F), IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 6 FELONY.

I understand that voter registration files, lists, or reports ("voter data") from Maricopa County's Voter Register are subject to protections and restrictions as provided by Arizona law. I agree to the following terms and conditions for receiving records electronically from the Maricopa County Recorder's Office and Elections Department:

1. Voter data is sought for authorized use. Precinct registers and other lists and information derived from registration forms may be used only for the following purposes:

- relating to a political or political party activity,
- a political campaign or an election,
- for revising election district boundaries or
- for any other purpose expressly authorized by law

Any person in possession of precinct registers or lists, in whole or part, or any reproduction of a precinct register or list, shall not permit the register or list to be used, bought, sold, or otherwise transferred for any purpose except for uses otherwise authorized.

2. Responsive records will not be used for commercial purposes. These records may not be used commercially as defined in A.R.S. § 39-121.03. The sale of registers, lists, and information derived from registration forms to a candidate or a registered political committee for a use specifically authorized by this subsection does not constitute use for a commercial purpose.

3. Internet Posting is Prohibited. A person possessing information derived from voter registration forms or precinct registers shall not distribute, post, or otherwise provide access to any portion of that information through the internet.

4. Charge for Records. The County Recorder, on a request for authorized use, shall prepare copies of records and furnish them to any person requesting them on payment of a fee equal to the following amounts for the following number of voter registration records provided:

5. If for authorized use, the following voter information will be redacted:

- the month and day of birth date,
- the social security number or any portion thereof,
- the driver's license number or non-operating identification license number,
- the Indian census number,
- the father's name or mother's maiden name,
- the state or country of birth
- the records containing a voter's signature
- voter's email address.

6. Unredacted voter data will be accessible to, or reproduced, only for the following individuals:

- the voter,
- an authorized government official in the scope of the official's duties,
- for any purpose by an entity designated by the Secretary of State as a voter registration agency pursuant to the national voter registration act (NVRA)
- for signature verification on petitions and candidate filings,
- for election purposes and
- for news gathering purposes by a person engaged in the newspaper, radio, television, or reportorial work, or connected with or employed by a newspaper, radio, or television station or pursuant to a court order.
- However, notwithstanding any other law, a voter's e-mail address may not be released for any purpose.
