

## VOTER REGISTRATION: A FORM FOR ALL 50 STATES

# Federal Form Required Fields

This form is accepted by all 50 states and can be used to register voters all over the country. These requirements are specific to Arizona. To find other state's requirements visit:

If proof of citizenship is not provided and the Maricopa County Recorder's Office (MCRO) cannot verify citizenship, the voter will be registered for a "Federal Only" ballot which only allows voters to participate in elections for: President, U.S. Senate, and U.S. Congress.

### \*What qualifies as Proof of Citizenship in Arizona?

Use one of these documents to prove citizenship:

- (1) Arizona Driver License/ State ID number
- (2) Tribal Identification Number
- (3) Alien Registration Number
- (4) Copy of Birth Certificate
- (5) Copy of Passport

### Why should I put the last four digits of my Social Security Number?

Social Security Numbers prove identity. Voters need to prove identity if they want to get their ballot by mail. This also helps confirm records with the Arizona MVD. MCRO will keep your information safe and secure.
