




# Maricopa County Online Redistricting




When creating a West-MEC plan, not all voting precincts can be assigned to a district, because they fall outside the district. The area outside the district is shaded gray.

If a voting precinct overlaps the border of West-MEC, only the areas of the precinct within the district will be considered for the redistricting plan.

# Maricopa County Online Redistricting



When completely clearing the plan, some precincts will remain assigned since they have elected officials in them and cannot be reassigned.





# Maricopa County Online Redistricting



When you check in your plans, all plans will be checked in at the same time and they will not be editable again.



After checking in your plans, you can still login and view your plans and the corresponding plan demographics, but all other options will be unavailable.
