# The Basics:

- Registration deadline is 29 days before each election.
- Voters may register at anytime—but if it is after the 29<sup>th</sup> day they are not eligible to vote in that election.
- We request that individuals registering voters turn in the registration forms to the County Recorder/Elections office within 5 days of their completion. (This is the legal requirement for all government agencies.)



# The Basics:

- Requirements to register to vote:
  - United States Citizen
  - Resident of the State of Arizona and the County listed on the registration
  - 18 years of age or older by the date of the next General Election




# The Basics:

- **Cannot** register if:
  - Not a United States Citizen (permanent resident **does not** qualify)
  - Convicted of more than 1 felony and have not had civil rights restored. (If it is the first conviction, the individual may re-register once all probationary requirements are met. Rights are not automatically restored if it is the second felony conviction or more, the court must be petitioned.)
  - Adjudicated incompetent.



# The Basics:

- The four recognized parties in Arizona for 2008 are the Democrat, Republican, Green, and the Libertarian Parties.
- Registrants **do not** have to select a party preference. If they fail to do so, or select a party other than one of the 4 recognized parties, in the Primary Election they would choose either a Democrat, Republican, or Green ballot.



# The Basics:

- Individuals in the naturalization process **CANNOT** register to vote until they have obtained citizenship status.
- Registering to vote when not a citizen jeopardizes the individuals chances to **EVER** become a US citizen.
- Executing a false registration is a Class 6 Felony.



# Prop 200

- Prop 200 was a voter initiative passed in the General Election of 2004.
- It requires voters to provide proof of **CITIZENSHIP** to register to vote & proof of **IDENTITY** to vote at the polls on Election Day.
- Voters already registered were not required to re-register.





## What has changed with Prop 200?



- **NEW** registrants to Maricopa County must provide **proof** of citizenship.
- If a voter is registered in the county and is updating registration (with new name, address, political party, etc.) they **DO NOT** have to provide citizenship documentation.
- If the registrant is unsure if they are already registered, it is to their benefit to include the documentation in case they are not registered.



## Proper Citizenship Identification: Copies to provide

- a driver license or nonoperating license from another state within the United States if the license indicates that the applicant has provided satisfactory proof of citizenship

# What has changed?

Registrant is not considered registered until citizenship is documented:

- Petition signatures are invalid if the signer registers at the same time and **does not** provide sufficient citizenship documentation as the registration will be rejected.
- Initial date of filling out form is irrelevant if form is insufficient. Date of registration will be date on new, comprehensive form.



# What if the voter doesn't have an address?

- Rural registrants or those without a physical address need to give a descriptive location so that they can be placed in a voting precinct.
- The bottom right corner of the form contains an area to draw where they reside.
- It is also helpful if someone else is registered who lives there (or nearby) to note their information



Just putting your social security number (or the last four of the number) will not suffice. Proof of citizenship must also accompany the registration form

# Completion of the Form:

- Be sure that the required fields are populated and that the voter has signed and dated the form.
- The more information that the voter fills in the better—we have 1.6 million voters and use the information to tell them apart!
- Give the voter the white copy or Voter Receipt.
- Do not hold forms! **Failure to do so may potentially disenfranchise the voter.**



# Turning in the Forms

- When forms are turned in you will be asked to provide the following:

- Your name and contact information
- A photo ID

- Why?

- The forms you turn in will be given a batch identification.
- We track the source of forms so that if there are any issues we know where the forms came from.
- Organizations abusing the voting public by holding forms and/or modifying the face of the forms without the voter's consent will be turned over to the County Attorney's office for investigation.



# Turning in the Forms

- When you turn in forms you will be able to get other forms at that time.
- Forms are distributed in lots of 200.
- If you make copies or print them off online the voter does not get a copy for their records.
- If you have a large event and think that you may need more than 200 it may be possible to make a special accommodation.



# Resolution of Insufficient Registrations:

Insufficient Registrations received by the department are sent :

- A letter informing the registrant what issue they need to resolve.
- A new voter registration form.
- A self-addressed stamped envelope.

# Insufficient forms:

- If the information which is missing does not pertain to the registrant's citizenship status they are still notified but the form is not rejected, it is put on suspense.
- The registrant has until 7 PM on Election Day to provide correct information.
- The registration form retains the original date.



# Insufficient forms:

- If citizenship information is missing the form is rejected completely.
- The registrant would have to completely re-register and provide the necessary information.
- We have rejected more than 30,000 forms since this was initiated in 2005.
- It is imperative to the voter that they are filled out correctly.



# Petitions

- Signatures gathered at the same time that the voter registers to vote will be invalidated if the registrant does not provide sufficient information to become registered.



# How does the voter know they are registered?

- Voters will receive a Voter ID card 3-6 weeks after their registration is received (time varies depending on volume of forms being processed).
- Voters should verify that all the information is correct and contact MCED if it is not.

# What has changed?

## Early Voting: Nothing has changed.

Voters may still request Early Ballots to be mailed to them beginning 93 days prior to the election via:

# Early Voting Sites

- Voters who go into an Early Voting Site beginning 33 days before the election until the Friday before the election ***will not be*** required to provide identification.

# What has changed? Voting at the Polls: A LOT!

Voters have 3 options at the polls:

1. Provide ONE form of photo ID off LIST ONE  
*or*
2. Provide TWO forms of non-photo ID off LIST TWO  
*or*
3. Vote a provisional ballot and provide ID within THREE days for a Jurisdictional/Primary Election, FIVE days for a Federal General Election.

## IDENTIFICATION AT THE POLLS



The elector shall announce his/her name and place of residence to the election official and present one form of identification from List #1 or two different forms of identification from List #2. [A.R.S. § 16-579(A)]

### **LIST #1 - Sufficient Photo ID including name and address** (ONE (1) Required)

- Valid Arizona driver license or non-operating identification
- Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
- Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued identification

### **LIST #2 - Sufficient ID without photograph bearing name and address** (TWO (2) Required)

- Utility bill of the elector that is dated within ninety days of the date of the election. A utility bill may be for electric, gas, water, solid waste, sewer, telephone, cellular phone, or cable television
- Bank or credit union statement that is dated within 90 days of the date of the election
- Valid Arizona Vehicle Registration
- Indian census card
- Property tax statement of the elector's residence
- Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
- Vehicle insurance card
- Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued identification
- Voter Registration Card / Recorder's Certification
- Any "Official Election Material" mailing bearing your name and address

An elector who does not provide sufficient identification shall not be issued a regular ballot, but shall receive a provisional ballot and will have **five (5) days** after a Federal General election and **three (3) days** after any other election to provide sufficient identification to the County Recorder in order for their provisional ballot to count.

## VOTER ASSISTANCE



Poll workers are available to assist voters with language translations, instructions on process, and with the physical act of voting.





## LIST ONE:

- If the voter provides a valid photo ID off of **LIST ONE** and they are in the Signature Roster **with the same address** they will be given a **standard ballot**.
- If the voter provides a valid photo ID off of **LIST ONE** and they are **NOT** in the Signature Roster at **the same address** they will be given a **Provisional Ballot** once it is determined they are in the correct polling place. The voter **will not** have to return.

A 'PROVISIONAL BALLOT / BOLETA PROVISIONAL' form. It includes sections for 'CURRENT INFORMATION' (name, address, date of birth), 'FORMER INFORMATION' (previous name, address), and 'BOX C / CAJA C' for signatures. The form is numbered 1 through 4 and includes a barcode and the number '8-10016829'.

## LIST TWO:

- If the voter provides **TWO** valid forms of ID off of **LIST TWO** and they are in the Signature Roster at the **same address** they will be given a standard ballot.
- If the voter provides **TWO** valid forms of ID off of **LIST TWO** and they are **NOT** in the Signature Roster at the **same address** they will be given a **provisional** ballot once it is determined they are in the correct polling place. The voter **will not** have to return.





# Exception to every rule:

- Identification Requirement for Native American Electors


An elector who identifies himself or herself as a member of a federally recognized Native American tribe and who does not provide one form of identification that bears the name, address, and photograph of the elector or two different forms of identification that bear the name and address of the elector shall be issued a provisional ballot upon presenting one form of tribal identification that bears the name of the elector and that reasonably appears to be the same as the signature roster or recorder's certificate.



# Examples of Tribal ID

- Tribal identification or enrollment card issued under the authority of a federally recognized Indian tribe, nation, community, or band ("tribe"), a tribal subdivision or the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
- Certificate of Indian Blood issued to a tribal member under the authority of a tribe or by the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
- Voter registration card for tribal elections issued under the authority of a tribe;
- Home site assignment lease, permit or allotment issued under the authority of a tribe, tribal subdivision, or by the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
- Grazing permit or allotment issued to a tribal member under the authority of a tribe, tribal subdivision, or by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

**SO:**



- If a voter has a Tribal ID that has their:
  - Photograph
  - Name
  - Date of Birth (for example)
  - Social Security Number (for example)
  - **BUT** no address
- They would vote a provisional ballot, but **DO NOT** have to return with any other ID.





# Insufficient ID or no ID at all:


- If the voter has insufficient identification or no ID, the voter can go home and get ID, return to the polling place before 7 PM, and vote a Standard Ballot:





# Insufficient ID or no ID at all:

- If the voter does not return to the polls, they can provide sufficient ID for the 3 days following a Jurisdictional or Primary Election or 5 days following a Federal General Election.
- Identification sites will be located:
  - At all 3 County Recorder's Offices
  - Town & City Clerk's Offices
  - All Early Voting Sites





## Insufficient ID or no ID at all:

If the voter does not return with sufficient identification their provisional ballot *will not* be processed.

Since the implementation of this requirement we have had almost 3,000 voters not return with ID and their ballots went unprocessed.

*So it is imperative that the voters get the right information and understand the requirements.*




