Goodyear Election to End Tonight at 7 pm

The election for the City of Goodyear wraps up today with voting closing at 7 pm. The Vote by Mail election returns are being processed by the Maricopa County Recorder's Office. Unofficial results will be issued tonight at 7 pm. The official results will be issued by close of business tomorrow.

As of this this afternoon, approximately 12,161 Goodyear citizens had returned their ballots out of the 43,244 requested ballots. This 28 percent participation rate is higher than the last two elections conducted in Goodyear.

Goodyear City Clerk Maureen Scott worked with the Maricopa County Elections Department Interim Director Rey Valenzuela to successfully conduct the all-mail election.

"We are pleased with the participation of so many of our citizens," Scott said. "Vote by Mail works great for our residents and encourages broad participation by the community."

"We love working with the City of Goodyear," Valenzuela said. "Clerk Scott and her team are a pleasure to work with and we are delighted to help the citizens of Goodyear with their Mayoral and Council elections."

Citizens of Goodyear registered to vote may go to City Hall at 190 N. Litchfield Road or the Maricopa County Elections offices at 510 S. 3rd Avenue, Phoenix and drop off their ballot until 7 pm today. Replacement ballots for those that are lost, misplaced, damaged or dirty may be obtained at Goodyear City Hall.
