EARLY VOTING BEGINS THURSDAY AUGUST 2 FOR PRIMARY ELECTION

July 24, 2012, Phoenix – Maricopa County Recorder, Helen Purcell, wants to remind everyone that **early voting** begins **Thursday, August 2**, for the 2012 Primary Election. Ballots will be dropped in the mail on the 2nd of August to voters who are on the permanent early voting list or who have requested to receive an early ballot.

Presently, 743,561 voters have signed up to be on the county elections’ permanent early voting list or requested an early ballot. At this time 1,003,285 registered voters are on the Permanent Early Voting List (PEVL) and 259,724 have not indicated their ballot choice. The county has nearly 1.9 million registered voters and Purcell anticipates that figure will increase as the General Election nears.

Last day to request an early ballot by mail for the Primary is August 17. Voters can still vote at an early voting satellite up through Friday, August 24, at 5pm. Some days and hours may vary at the following locations.
