### MARCH 2010 JURISDICTIONAL EARLY VOTING REQUESTS CLOSES FRIDAY

**February 25, 2010 – Phoenix, AZ:** Requests for an early ballot for the March 9<sup>th</sup> jurisdictional elections closes at 5:00pm this Friday, February 26, 2010. Voters may still vote early in person the last week before the election at any of the three offices of the Maricopa County Recorder, 111 South 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Phoenix; 510 South Third Avenue, Phoenix; and 222 East Javelina, Mesa. In-person voting closes on Friday, March 5 at 5pm.

Jurisdictions whose offices will be open for their own early balloting are city of Scottsdale, and city of Tempe. Replacement ballots may be secured at town of Buckeye, town of Carefree, city of Litchfield Park, town of Paradise Valley, and town of Queen Creek. Town of Fountain Hills will be a drop-off site only. Early Voting hours are during regular office hours and replacement sites will be open until 7pm on election day.

Jurisdictions holding elections on March 9 are: Arlington Elementary School District No.47, town of Buckeye, town of Carefree, Deer Valley Unified School District No.97, Dysart Unified School District No.89, town of Fountain Hills, Glendale Elementary School District No.40, Isaac Elementary School District No.5, Kyrene Elementary School District No.28, Laveen Elementary School District No.59, city of Litchfield Park, Palo Verde Elementary School District No.49, town of Paradise Valley, Phoenix Union High School District No.210, town of Queen Creek, city of Scottsdale, city of Tempe, Tempe Elementary School District No.3, Tolleson Union High School District No.214, and Union Elementary School District No.62. Town of Buckeye, Carefree, Paradise Valley, Queen Creek and city of Litchfield Park are holding all mail ballot elections.

As of today 330,394 early ballots have been requested or mailed and 111,798 have been returned.

### SOLICITUDES PARA VOTACIÓN TEMPRANA PARA LAS JURISDICCIONALES DE MARZO DEL 2010 CIERRAN EL VIERNES

**Febrero 25, 2010 – Phoenix, AZ:** Las solicitudes para una boleta temprana para las elecciones jurisdiccionales del 9 de Marzo cierran a las 5:00pm éste Viernes 26 de Febrero del 2010. Los votantes aún pueden votar temprano en persona la última semana antes de la elección en cualquiera de las tres oficinas del Registrador del Condado Maricopa, 111 South 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Phoenix; 510 South Third Avenue, Phoenix; and 222 East Javelina, Mesa. La votación en persona cierra el Viernes, 5 de Marzo a las 5pm.

Las jurisdicciones cuyas oficinas estarán abiertas para su propia votación temprana son ciudad de Scottsdale, y ciudad de Tempe. Boletas de reemplazo pueden ser aseguradas en el pueblo de Buckeye, pueblo de Carefree, ciudad de Litchfield Park, pueblo de Paradise Valley, y pueblo de Queen Creek. El pueblo de Fountain Hills será un sitio de entrega solamente. Las horas de Votación Temprana son durante horas regulares de oficina y los sitios de reemplazo estarán abiertos hasta las 7 pm el día de elección.

Las jurisdicciones conduciendo elecciones el 9 de Marzo son: Distrito Escolar Primario Arlington No.47, Pueblo de Buckeye, Pueblo de Carefree, Distrito Escolar Unificado Deer Valley No.97, Distrito Escolar Unificado Dysart No.89, Pueblo de Fountain Hills, Distrito Escolar Primario Glendale No. 40, Distrito Escolar Primario Isaac No. 5, Distrito Escolar Primario Kyrene No.28, Distrito Escolar Primario Laveen No.59, Ciudad de Litchfield Park, Distrito Escolar Primario Palo Verde No..49, Pueblo de Paradise Valley, Distrito Escolar Superior Phoenix Union No..210, Pueblo de Queen Creek, Ciudad de Scottsdale, Ciudad de Tempe, Distrito Escolar Primario Tempe No.3, Distrito Escolar Superior Tolleson No.214, y Distrito Escolar primario Union No.62. El Pueblo de Buckeye, Carefree, Paradise Valley, Queen Creek y ciudad de Litchfield Park estarán conduciendo elecciones solo por correo. Hasta hoy 330.394 boletas tempranas han sido solicitadas o enviadas por correo y 111,798 han sido devueltas.
