MARICOPA COUNTY RECORDER HAS ANOTHER FIRST

December 1, 2009 – Phoenix, AZ Maricopa County Recorder Helen Purcell will soon reveal the first recording kiosk in the United States. “We will be offering the public an option to record a document via an interactive KIOSK,” reported Ms. Purcell. “It will have the capability of housing a computer terminal with touch screen ability, document scanning and printing, audio, video and credit card reader; and it will permit the public to record their document via a KIOSK while in direct communication with one of our employees.”

It is envisioned that the KIOSK will be a remote extension of the recording counter without the need to physically visit the downtown Phoenix office or the Recorder’s southeast office in Mesa. Because it is a wireless technology, there will be no connection to the Maricopa County’s network, thereby allowing future KIOSK placement in different locations, i.e. city and town government offices, libraries, federal buildings and malls as an example. This will eliminate the need for the public to make the drive to the Recorder’s offices to conduct business.

It is a huge accommodation for public use, helps the environment and will add to the overall efficiency of the Maricopa County Recorder’s Office. Although the present KIOSK is not permanently on display, it is functional and should be launched in mid December 2009 in the Recorder’s Office.
