



# PPE vs. Primary



- The Presidential Preference Election is an election for the applicable party to determine who their convention delegates will vote for in the first round at the party's national convention ***of party members.***
- The Primary election is the path for candidates to get on the ballot for the General Election, and therefore, have an opportunity to be elected to office by the ***entire voting public.***



There are NO Presidential candidates on Arizona's PRIMARY Election ballot!

# Presidential Preference Election

- Parties notify the Secretary of State if they wish to participate



# Presidential Preference Election



- Be a qualified candidate in 2 other states

**OR**

- Collect 500 signatures

  - November 13, 2015
- Last day to file:



# Voter Registration


- The deadline for the Presidential Preference Election was February 22, 2016.
- Must be registered with a recognized party in order to be eligible to vote in this election
  - Democratic
  - Green
  - Republican

# Early Voting

- Early Voting for the PPE began February 24, 2016
  - 10% of early ballots sent, already returned
- 3 Early Voting sites
  - Downtown
  - Mesa
  - MCTEC
- March 8 vs. March 22
  - Different PO Box for PPE

# Alternative Ballot Format

- As of 3/1/16
  - 15 Braille
  - 94 Large Print
  - 3 Tohono O'Odham



# When to Return Early Ballot

- If mailing ballot
  - Put in mail Wednesday before Election (3/16/2016)
- Any time before Election Day
  - Downtown
  - Mesa
  - MCTEC
- On Election Day
  - Downtown, Mesa, MCTEC
  - ANY polling place within the County

# One Issue

- We are seeing
  - Ballots printed 45 days before election for UOCAVA voters
  - Early Voting ballot packets prepared at least a week before voter registration cutoff
  - Early voters who switched parties between when the early voting packets were prepared for mailing & the voter registration cutoff are receiving “wrong” (other party’s) ballot.
    - Democrats to Republican
    - Republican to Democrat

# Voting Precincts?

- **PRECINCTS GONE**

- Required to report by Congressional District – not precinct

- Use of Electronic Poll Books

- Number of PEVL

- **SO.....**

- Maricopa County submitted proposal for 60 polling places to BOS
