


It all started out so well.

Labor Day Impact:

- Shortage of boardworkers-many going out of town or had not yet returned to the Valley for the winter.







- TSs picked up Inspector Packets of last minute information for the polls






Opening the polls






Primary '08 Turnout by Party:






Early Voting: By Mail PEVL vs. Per Election



- Early ballots sent in by voters which are damaged or marked with a marking device (red pen, crayon, highlighter, etc) which the machine cannot read must be duplicated.

Write Ins

- Arizona has a partisan primary—voters registered to one of the 4 recognized parties were only eligible to vote in their party’s primary.

Some voters wanted both:



There are 2.7 million registered voters in Arizona and we expect voter turnout this election to be as high as 80%. As a poll worker, you will:


- set up and take down voting equipment

The Primary Election is on September 2 and the General is on November 4.







Boardworker Recruitment; # Hired by Affiliation








Bilingual Boardworker Total Recruitment



Boardworker Recruitment: Bilingual BW Totals




Boardworker Recruitment: Bilingual BW Coverage






Boardworker Recruitment: Student Bilingual BWs
