# The Basics:

- Registration deadline is 29 days before each election.
- Voters may register at anytime—but if it is after the 29<sup>th</sup> day they are not eligible to vote in that election.
- We request that individuals registering voters turn in the registration forms to the County Recorder/Elections office within 5 days of their completion. (This is the legal requirement for all government agencies.)



# The Basics:

- Requirements to register to vote:
  - United States Citizen
  - Resident of the State of Arizona and the County listed on the registration
  - 18 years of age or older by the date of the next General Election





# The Basics:

- **Cannot** register if:
  - Not a United States Citizen (permanent resident **does not** qualify)
  - Convicted of more than 1 felony and have not had civil rights restored. (If it is the first conviction, the individual may re-register once all probationary requirements are met. Rights are not automatically restored if it is the second felony conviction or more, the court must be petitioned.)
  - Adjudicated incompetent.



# The Basics:

- The five recognized parties in Arizona for 2011-2012 are the Americans Elect, Democratic, Green, Libertarian, and Republican Parties.
- Registrants **do not** have to select a party preference. If they fail to do so, or select a party other than one of the five recognized parties, in the Primary Election they can choose any party's ballot except the Libertarian.



# The Basics:

- Individuals in the naturalization process **CANNOT** register to vote until they have obtained citizenship status.
- Registering to vote when not a citizen jeopardizes the individuals chances to **EVER** become a US citizen.
- Executing a false registration is a Class 6 Felony.



# Prop 200

- Prop 200 was a voter initiative passed in the General Election of 2004.
- It requires voters to provide proof of **CITIZENSHIP** to register to vote & proof of **IDENTITY** to vote at the polls on Election Day.
- Voters already registered were not required to re-register.





## What has changed with Prop 200?


- **NEW** registrants to Maricopa County must provide **proof** of citizenship.
- If a voter is registered in the county and is updating registration (with new name, address, political party, etc.) they **DO NOT** have to provide citizenship documentation.
- If the registrant is unsure if they are already registered, it is to their benefit to include the documentation in case they are not registered.







# What if the voter doesn't have an address?

- Rural registrants or those without a physical address need to give a descriptive location so that they can be placed in a voting precinct.
- The bottom right corner of the form contains an area to draw where they reside.
- It is also helpful if someone else is registered who lives there (or nearby) to note their information

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



# Completion of the Form:

- Be sure that the required fields are populated and that the voter has signed and dated the form.
- The more information that the voter fills in the better—we have 2.1 million voters and use the information to tell them apart!
- Give the voter the white copy or Voter Receipt.
- Do not hold forms! **Failure to do so may potentially disenfranchise the voter.**



# Turning in the Forms

- When forms are turned in you will be asked to provide the following:

- Your name and contact information
- A photo ID

- Why?

- The forms you turn in will be given a batch identification.
- We track the source of forms so that if there are any issues we know where the forms came from.
- Organizations abusing the voting public by holding forms and/or modifying the face of the forms without the voter's consent will be turned over to the County Attorney's office for investigation.



# Turning in the Forms

- When you turn in forms you will be able to get other forms at that time.
- Forms are distributed in lots of 200.
- If you make copies or print them off online the voter does not get a copy for their records.
- If you have a large event and think that you may need more than 200 it may be possible to make a special accommodation.



# Resolution of Insufficient Registrations:

Insufficient Registrations received by the department are sent :

- A letter informing the registrant what issue they need to resolve.
- A new voter registration form.
- A self-addressed stamped envelope.

# Insufficient forms:

- If the information which is missing does not pertain to the registrant's citizenship status they are still notified but the form is not rejected, it is put on suspense.
- The registrant has until 7 PM on Election Day to provide correct information.
- The registration form retains the original date.



# Insufficient forms:

- If citizenship information is missing the form is rejected completely.
- The registrant would have to completely re-register and provide the necessary information.
- We have rejected more than 50,000 forms since this was initiated in 2005.
- It is imperative to the voter that they are filled out correctly.



# How does the voter know they are registered?

- Voters will receive a Voter ID card 3-6 weeks after their registration is received (time varies depending on volume of forms being processed).
- Voters should verify that all the information is correct and contact MCED if it is not.

# What has changed?

## Early Voting: Nothing has changed.

Voters may still request Early Ballots to be mailed to them beginning 93 days prior to the election via:

# Early Voting Sites

- Voters who go into an Early Voting Site beginning 26 days before the election until the Friday before the election ***will not be*** required to provide identification.


This publicity pamphlet has the Official Election Logo and the voter's name and address; it WILL work as one form of ID off of List 2.



# Previously these were not usable due to lack of address.



But now they can be used in combination with a non-photo ID from List 2 which has an address on it. If the address is the same as the Roster they get a standard ballot, if it's different address they vote a provisional ballot and **DO NOT** have to return.

# Exception to every rule:

- Identification Requirement for Native American Electors

An elector who identifies himself or herself as a member of a federally recognized Native American tribe and who does not provide one form of identification that bears the name, address, and photograph of the elector or two different forms of identification that bear the name and address of the elector shall be issued a provisional ballot upon presenting one form of tribal identification that bears the name of the elector and that reasonably appears to be the same as the signature roster or recorder's certificate.




# Examples of Tribal ID

- Tribal identification or enrollment card issued under the authority of a federally recognized Indian tribe, nation, community, or band ("tribe"), a tribal subdivision or the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
- Certificate of Indian Blood issued to a tribal member under the authority of a tribe or by the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
- Voter registration card for tribal elections issued under the authority of a tribe;
- Home site assignment lease, permit or allotment issued under the authority of a tribe, tribal subdivision, or by the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
- Grazing permit or allotment issued to a tribal member under the authority of a tribe, tribal subdivision, or by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.


# Insufficient ID or no ID at all:

- If the voter has insufficient identification or no ID, the voter can go home and get ID, return to the polling place before 7 PM, and vote a Standard Ballot:



# Insufficient ID or no ID at all:


- Or the voter can vote a Provisional Ballot, but identification will still be necessary in order for the ballot to be processed.
- The voter can go home, get ID, and return to the polling place while the polls are open:



A form is filled out to show that the voter returned with ID so that their Provisional Ballot can be processed. The form will be deposited in the Provisional Ballot box.

# Insufficient ID or no ID at all:

- If the voter does not return to the polls, they can provide sufficient ID for the 3 days following a Jurisdictional or Primary Election or 5 days following a Federal General Election.
- Identification sites will be located:
  - At all 3 County Recorder's Offices
  - Town & City Clerk's Offices
  - All Early Voting Sites





## Insufficient ID or no ID at all:

If the voter does not return with sufficient identification their provisional ballot *will not* be processed.

Since the implementation of this requirement we have had almost 6,000 voters not return with ID and their ballots went unprocessed.

*So it is imperative that the voters get the right information and understand the requirements.*
